STUDY ABROAD in SWITZERLAND

with the Department of Communication at Virginia Tech

About the Program

International Perspectives on Communication is designed for students who want the study abroad experience without the long-term commitment. Students earn six credit hours during the Summer I term. Two weeks of coursework is completed at the Steger Center in Riva San Vitale, Switzerland and the remainder of the course is completed online from anywhere in the world. Students have the option to return home or travel throughout Europe on their own. Students will also enroll in a one-hour spring semester course to prepare for the trip.

For the Summer 2020 trip, we will be in Switzerland **June 4 - 18**. Students will have the opportunity to spend time in Geneva, Switzerland to visit the United Nations as well as have two "free weekends" to travel independently.
